IMPORTANT

Due to the Corona Virus outbreak we have recently been advised by the Royal NZ College of GPs that we need to significantly re organise the way we see people in the surgery. This is to prevent community transmission within GP Surgery waiting room. Therefore the majority of our consultations will now take place over the phone and hopefully soon we should have the capability for video link consultation. Some people will still need to come into the surgery. We ask that you notify us of your arrival (by phoning reception) and then wait in your car until we call you on your cellphone to come directly into the doctor's room.

- 1. All routine screening procedures (cervical smears, diabetes checks etc) will be suspended for the immediate future.
- 2. Childhood immunisations will continue as normal.
- 3. Flu vaccinations for over 65 and people with coexisting (subsidised) health conditions will be our priority. Please DO NOT come for your flu vaccination if you are unwell with cough or flu like symptoms.
- 4. Once the above population have been vaccinated for flu we will then be able to vaccinate others.

Please be aware this is a very busy time for General Practice and our front line reception staff in particular. Please be aware of the pressure on our staff and ensure that your call or visit is essential. We would like to thank you for your support and understanding. Updates will be posted on the website as they occur.

We ask that any patients with flu type symptoms ring reception and a nurse will talk to you before an appointment is made. We are working within guidelines to minimize the risk of spreading this highly contagious illness. Your co operation is much appreciated. There are daily updates available on the Ministry of Health website (www.health.govt.nz) We recommend that you get all your information from this source and NOT from social media.

Here are some tips to avoid spreading virus: – Wash your hands often with soap and water or use alcohol-based sanitiser – Avoid touching your nose, eyes and mouth unnecessarily (they are gateways for colds and viruses to enter the body)
